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00:00:27,720 --> 00:00:33,960 Welcome to the first Receivership Town Hall, which we are live streaming on our new YouTube channel.

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00:00:35,340 --> 00:00:41,400 I'm going to spend most of this Town Hall addressing the EminiFX users directly. I

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00:00:41,400 --> 00:00:46,080 understand this has been an extraordinarily difficult situation for many users.

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00:00:46,800 --> 00:00:52,620 And so, during the next hour, I'm going to discuss what I, along with my team of

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00:00:52,620 --> 00:00:58,140 dedicated professionals, have been doing on behalf of all users and other constituents.

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00:01:00,000 --> 00:01:02,340 Let me give some brief background on my appointment.

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00:01:03,180 --> 00:01:09,300 On May 11, 2022, Judge Valerie Caproni, of the Southern District of New York,

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00:01:10,020 --> 00:01:15,420 that's the federal court in Manhattan, appointed me as receiver on an emergency

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00:01:15,420 --> 00:01:23,400 basis in a civil enforcement action brought by the Commodity Futures Trading Commission, the CFTC,

00:01:24,120 --> 00:01:31,740 against EminiFX and Eddy Alexandre. That appointment was made permanent on June 15,

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00:01:31,740 --> 00:01:38,640 2022, in the consent order submitted jointly by Eddy Alexandre and the CFTC.

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00:01:39,960 --> 00:01:43,680 As an independent fiduciary, I report to the court.

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00:01:44,220 --> 00:01:51,480 Not to the parties. My job is to preserve and administer the assets of EminiFX.

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00:01:53,280 --> 00:01:58,800 I am appointed in the Civil Enforcement Case. That is a separate case than the

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00:01:58,800 --> 00:02:04,620 criminal case that was against Eddy Alexandre individually, and was before a different judge.

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00:02:05,700 --> 00:02:12,780 In February of this year, Mr. Alexandre pled guilty to one count of commodities fraud in

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00:02:12,780 --> 00:02:19,440 connection with the operation of EminiFX. Many of you are aware that, in that matter,

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00:02:19,440 --> 00:02:25,140 Mr. Alexandre was sentenced to nine years in federal prison and ordered to pay restitution.

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00:02:26,040 --> 00:02:31,620 And my office is coordinating with the Department of Justice on restitution issues.

00:02:33,180 --> 00:02:39,360 When I took over as Receiver, I heard from many of you who are listening in today.

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00:02:40,380 --> 00:02:44,280 Many of you who put your money into EminiFX did so

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00:02:45,000 --> 00:02:50,400 in the hope of achieving financial freedom, as hundreds of you have told me.

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00:02:51,240 --> 00:02:58,320 Many users signed a petition at the beginning of this case explaining how they thought they were

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00:02:58,320 --> 00:03:03,840 able to access their funds, including the investment returns, at any time.

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00:03:04,800 --> 00:03:07,320 Unfortunately, as I will explain,

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00:03:07,320 --> 00:03:14,760 the investment returns that appeared in your EminiFX dashboard were not real.

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00:03:15,600 --> 00:03:23,940 The balance displayed on the dashboard was not actually reflected in assets that were in EminiFX.

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00:03:24,960 --> 00:03:30,720 What was remaining when I was appointed was only a third of the dashboard balances.

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00:03:31,560 --> 00:03:38,280 So, all that was left was some, but not all, of the millions of dollars that were contributed

00:03:38,280 --> 00:03:46,200 by the users, by the members. There were no profits. No positive returns on investments.

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00:03:47,820 --> 00:03:54,480 My initial goal was to preserve the value of EminiFX by getting all the assets and the money

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00:03:54,480 --> 00:04:02,280 under our control, and into safe interest-bearing accounts. That process is largely complete,

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00:04:02,280 --> 00:04:11,160 and we now have over 153 million dollars in insured bank accounts earning over 3% interest.

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00:04:12,840 --> 00:04:20,520 Now, my primary goal is to get what money we can back to EminiFX users and other people impacted

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00:04:20,520 --> 00:04:29,520 by the EminiFX scheme. I do not I do expect to be able to return a significant amount of funds that

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00:04:29,520 --> 00:04:36,000 users contributed to EminiFX. So, although I do expect to return a significant amount,

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00:04:36,000 --> 00:04:43,260 at this stage, however I cannot promise anyone exactly how much they will get.

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00:04:44,100 --> 00:04:49,500 The timing of future distributions is also uncertain at this time.

40 00:04:50,760 --> 00:04:58,440 All of these distribution issues will be the subject of a future motion to the Court. What

00:04:58,440 --> 00:05:06,840 I can say now is that a distribution to EminiFX users and other claimants is my top priority.

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00:05:09,360 --> 00:05:14,280 A little later in this Town Hall, I'm going to touch on the court-approved

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00:05:14,280 --> 00:05:20,040 transaction verification process, as we are bringing the EminiFX User Portal

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00:05:20,040 --> 00:05:26,940 online next week. I'll also answer some questions from the from EminiFX users.

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00:05:28,500 --> 00:05:34,980 If you have any questions during the presentation, you can email EminiFx@Stretto.com.

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00:05:43,260 --> 00:05:50,160 Before we get into the substance, I want to quickly explain the roles of my professionals.

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00:05:50,820 --> 00:05:56,280 Assisting me are Otterbourg for legal, JS held for financial investigation,

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00:05:56,280 --> 00:06:01,980 Deloitte and Crowe for taxes, and Stretto for claims administration.

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00:06:03,360 --> 00:06:08,160 Stretto is very important, because they will serve as your primary point of contact

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00:06:08,160 --> 00:06:14,100 when interacting with the Receivership. They are going to be the ones to help me

00:06:14,100 --> 00:06:21,600 work with you to verify what you put in to EminiFX, and what you got out of EminiFX. 52 00:06:23,580 --> 00:06:31,440 Stretto also hosts our website at www.eminifxreceivership.com. 53 00:06:32,700 --> 00:06:37,380 That website is available in Haitian Creole and French as well as English. 54 00:06:38,100 --> 00:06:44,820 That website also has all the Court filings and the status reports that 55 00:06:44,820 --> 00:06:50,460 go into more detail on some of the topics that I will discuss in this Town Hall. 56 00:06:52,020 --> 00:06:57,060 Stretto may also send you emails from time to time. You have probably seen some already. 57 00:06:57,840 --> 00:07:04,800 When you get one, I'd ask you to open it, read it, and follow any instructions in that email. 58 00:07:05,820 --> 00:07:11,220 We will also periodically use e-mails to remind you of upcoming deadlines. 59 00:07:14,100 --> 00:07:20,100 Now, let's get into the substance. I'm going to start with how EminiFX worked. 60 00:07:20,880 --> 00:07:27,420 My team and I have looked at the internal company system, as well as the bank, brokerage 61

00:07:27,420 --> 00:07:34,200 and cryptocurrency records that we were able to obtain directly from those financial institutions.

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00:07:35,400 --> 00:07:41,220 We have used that data to analyze and understand how EminiFX worked.

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00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:47,520 We looked at the balances that users saw in their accounts usually, in the dashboard.

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00:07:48,480 --> 00:07:54,300 We also looked at the assets and money that actually existed. Unfortunately,

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00:07:54,300 --> 00:08:00,960 there was no connection between the balances on the dashboard and the actual underlying assets.

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00:08:02,160 --> 00:08:06,600 So, let's start with what I mean by an EminiFX user.

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00:08:07,320 --> 00:08:12,900 I mean someone who created a username or an account on the EminiFX system.

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00:08:13,740 --> 00:08:21,540 And who deposited money or cryptocurrency, such as Bitcoin. Or who withdrew money or cryptocurrency.

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00:08:22,980 --> 00:08:30,660 A lot of users have referred to themselves in communications with me as "members." Given the

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00:08:30,660 --> 00:08:37,440 way this system worked, I prefer to use the term "EminiFX Users," as some of you may have seen on

00:08:37,440 --> 00:08:43,860 our website. But from your perspective, "member" and "user" will generally mean the same thing.

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00:08:46,260 --> 00:08:52,620 Thousands of users deposited money into EminiFX. Often, this was in the form of

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00:08:52,620 --> 00:08:58,800 U.S. dollar cash deposits into the company accounts at TD Bank or Bank of America.

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00:08:59,580 --> 00:09:06,540 Or via wire transfer into those accounts. In addition, the most common way to make a deposit

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00:09:06,540 --> 00:09:14,400 was to use Bitcoin via the CoinPayments system. So I've used the word "deposit." But, given the

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00:09:14,400 --> 00:09:22,080 way the system worked, going forward I'm going to use the term "contribution," instead. That said,

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00:09:22,080 --> 00:09:29,160 for users from your perspective "deposit" and "contribution" will generally mean the same thing.

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00:09:31,860 --> 00:09:34,980 When users contributed dollars or Bitcoin,

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00:09:34,980 --> 00:09:41,640 they could then log onto their account and see that money in their EminiFX dashboard.

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00:09:41,640 --> 00:09:48,060 Usually in their e-wallet. Most users would then put funds into their trading wallet,

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00:09:48,060 --> 00:09:57,000

as that is what was used for the weekly Return on Investment, or ROI, increases every Friday. 82 00:09:58,200 --> 00:10:04,500 Specifically, every Friday morning. The dashboard would show a payout of ROI. 83 00:10:05,220 --> 00:10:15,420 That would be between 5.00 and 9.99 percent, across the board. On March 11, 2022, it was 9.99%. 84 00:10:16,740 --> 00:10:26,160 On April 1, it was 9.91%. On April 22, it was 5.05%. And so on and so on. 85 00:10:28,080 --> 00:10:33,060 One EminiFX user wrote me that every Friday was like Christmas morning. 86 00:10:34,140 --> 00:10:41,100 And I understand why one might think that. The dashboard always showed an increase. 87 00:10:42,540 --> 00:10:49,680 It's not surprising that some users have said they thought they could become millionaires in a year. 88 00:10:50,760 --> 00:10:55,920 The problem is that none of those increases were real. 89 00:11:02,640 --> 00:11:10,140 I know this can be hard to hear. It is important that I emphasize this point, though. 90 00:11:10,860 --> 00:11:17,100 Because many EminiFX users have said in online petitions, in letters to me, 91 00:11:17,100 --> 00:11:22,860

in letters to the Court, and in other places, that they believed the profits were real. 92 00:11:23,820 --> 00:11:28,920 But they were not. The ROI numbers were fiction. Every week. 93 00:11:30,300 --> 00:11:35,160 So, how do we know that the ROI numbers were fiction? 94 00:11:36,060 --> 00:11:44,100 Well, we know that because we looked through everything EminiF EminiFX invested in. 95 00:11:44,100 --> 00:11:51,120 And we looked in detail. I've gone through this in some of my public reports filed with the court, 96 00:11:51,780 --> 00:11:56,400 most notably the Financial Condition Report filed in May 2023. 97 00:11:57,420 --> 00:12:03,360 Annex A to that report, available on our website, contains the weekly performance reports. 98 00:12:04,440 --> 00:12:09,780 Here, at this Town Hall, I'm going to provide an overview of what we found. 99 00:12:11,280 --> 00:12:14,280 There were three basic categories of investment. 100 00:12:15,120 --> 00:12:20,040 One, Securities and derivatives via an online brokerage account. 101 00:12:20,880 --> 00:12:28,200 Two, real estate Investments. And three

cryptocurrency holdings. Let's go through each. 102 00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:35,040 But first, the brokerage account. That was an account in Eddy Alexandre's name, 103 00:12:35,040 --> 00:12:40,320 but it was funded with nine million dollars of money from the corporate bank accounts. 104 00:12:41,100 --> 00:12:45,180 So it was ultimately funded with the contributions of the users. 105 00:12:46,740 --> 00:12:54,000 I looked at all the trading records, including the daily balances. In just over four months 106 00:12:54,000 --> 00:13:00,720 of trading, over seven million dollars was lost, a decline of approximately 80%. 107 00:13:02,100 --> 00:13:07,500 The losses continued to mount in most weeks, and the account never turned a profit. 108 00:13:08,460 --> 00:13:11,940 So there was no ROI from the brokerage trading. 109 00:13:13,140 --> 00:13:20,700 Second, there were also real estate investment. When I was appointed EminiFX was in contract to 110 00:13:20,700 --> 00:13:26,880 purchase 46 different foreclosure properties in Long Island, that's Nassau and Suffolk County. 111 00:13:27,960 --> 00:13:31,980 There were contracts for three other properties as well in the same counties.

112 00:13:32,820 --> 00:13:36,960 Most of the contracts were signed in the few weeks before I was appointed, 113 00:13:36,960 --> 00:13:40,980 but none of those properties had actually been purchased. 114 00:13:42,360 --> 00:13:46,980 We obtained professional valuations on all 46 foreclosure properties, 115 00:13:47,700 --> 00:13:52,620 and we tested the market for the properties that had the most potential upside. 116 00:13:53,280 --> 00:13:59,160 There were no takers. No buyers. So we did not go through with any of the purchases. 117 00:14:01,140 --> 00:14:07,620 Based on our analysis, EminiFX was likely looking at losses of several million dollars if these 118 00:14:07,620 --> 00:14:13,920 properties had all been purchased. Based on public sale records, one property alone would have had 119 00:14:13,920 --> 00:14:23,340 would have lost 850 thousand dollars if that deal had closed. Given the timing of the contracts, 120 00:14:23,340 --> 00:14:30,000 and the valuation of the properties, there was clearly no ROI from the real estate investments. 121 00:14:31,440 --> 00:14:34,980

Finally the third category was cryptocurrency.

00:14:35,880 --> 00:14:41,640 I say this even though I did not find a lot of active investment in cryptocurrencies.

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00:14:42,420 --> 00:14:49,260 However, most of the funds that were contributed by users came in via the CoinPayment system,

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00:14:49,920 --> 00:14:58,260 and were held there in that account as Bitcoin. So it was more, and more, and more Bitcoin kept

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00:14:58,260 --> 00:15:05,340 coming into the CoinPayments account, a lot of EminiFX's money was being held as Bitcoin.

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00:15:07,080 --> 00:15:12,900 That means that EminiFX was at least passively investing in Bitcoin.

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00:15:12,900 --> 00:15:18,000 If Bitcoin went up, or down, the value of EminiFX went up,

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00:15:18,000 --> 00:15:25,560 or down. Now whether that exposure to the price of Bitcoin was intended, I cannot say.

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00:15:26,940 --> 00:15:33,540 What we do know is that in 2022, the price of Bitcoin was on a downward trajectory,

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00:15:33,540 --> 00:15:41,820 with a big crash in early May. That meant that EminiFX kept losing millions of dollars as the

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00:15:41,820 --> 00:15:47,940 price of Bitcoin continued to fall. By the time I was appointed, there were over 40

132 00:15:47,940 --> 00:15:54,060 million dollars in losses in the Bitcoin that was held in the CoinPayments account. 133 00:15:55,020 --> 00:16:03,900 So there was no ROI, no positive ROI from the EminiFX exposure to the price of Bitcoin. 134 00:16:05,280 --> 00:16:10,620 On top of all that, the company spent about six million dollars in operating costs, 135 00:16:10,620 --> 00:16:18,120 in just a few months. Most of that was spent on salaries, rent, office equipment, and vehicles. 136 00:16:19,800 --> 00:16:26,580 So let's add it all up. We have millions of dollars in losses in the brokerage account. 137 00:16:27,180 --> 00:16:29,700 We have no real gains in real estate. 138 00:16:30,840 --> 00:16:37,680 We have tens of millions of dollars of losses in Bitcoin. And we have millions of dollars in costs. 139 00:16:38,280 --> 00:16:44,880 We have no gains anywhere. And that's how we know that the ROI was fiction. 140 00:16:46,020 --> 00:16:50,580 Because even though there were only actual losses and costs. the dashboard 141 00:16:50,580 --> 00:16:56,880 kept showing gains week after week after week. And that creates a weekly shortfall,

00:16:56,880 --> 00:17:01,020 meaning that there was a difference between the total value that users

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00:17:01,020 --> 00:17:07,440 could see in their accounts, and the assets that EminiFX actually had.

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00:17:08,880 --> 00:17:16,980 Moreover, we can measure that shortfall. By the time I was appointed in May 2022, it was immense.

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00:17:18,240 --> 00:17:23,460 At that time, the total difference between what the EminiFX dashboard

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00:17:23,460 --> 00:17:30,420 said all of your accounts were worth, and the money that EminiFX actually had in its

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00:17:30,420 --> 00:17:37,800 various accounts and other assets, that shortfall was over 300 million dollars.

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00:17:39,480 --> 00:17:44,640 Given the losses in the trading, and looking at the price of the Bitcoin since,

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00:17:45,420 --> 00:17:51,060 there was no reasonable path to ever make up that shortfall. In fact,

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00:17:51,060 --> 00:17:56,520 it was just getting worse when I was appointed, week after week after week

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00:18:02,160 --> 00:18:08,040 So let's talk about withdrawals. Some of you might be asking how there could 00:18:08,040 --> 00:18:15,660 be no ROI when it showed up on the dashboard every Friday morning. And you might ask how 153 00:18:15,660 --> 00:18:20,820 the dashboard could be fiction if you could withdraw it the money that was displayed. 154 00:18:21,600 --> 00:18:28,620 And the answer is simple. When you withdrew from EminiFX, you were not being paid with 155 00:18:28,620 --> 00:18:36,000 profits. Because no profits existed as we just explained. Rather you were being paid with the 156 00:18:36,000 --> 00:18:42,180 contributions of other users. In other words the contributions of other members of the community. 157 00:18:43,680 --> 00:18:46,620 And that's how Ponzi scheme generally works. 158 00:18:47,340 --> 00:18:53,940 So in in the classic Ponzi scheme, people put money into the scheme with the promise 159 00:18:53,940 --> 00:19:00,720 of very high returns. Those returns are not real, but people think they are. 160 00:19:01,380 --> 00:19:08,760 So when a user or contributor to the Ponzi scheme withdraws their money, then the promoter of that 161 00:19:08,760 --> 00:19:16,740 scheme uses the money that other users invested in order to make the payment to the withdrawing user. 162 00:19:18,420 --> 00:19:21,840

And that's what happened here. In fact, the judge overseeing 163 00:19:21,840 --> 00:19:28,200 the criminal case characterized EminiFX a Ponzi scheme during the sentencing hearing. 164 00:19:29,640 --> 00:19:35,520 I'm going to explain how we know that withdrawals were funded with other people's money. 165 00:19:36,720 --> 00:19:43,020 First, we know that withdrawals were made from the EminiFX CoinPayments account. 166 00:19:43,920 --> 00:19:50,580 Even though users withdrew in dollars, almost all withdrawals were paid in Bitcoin via 167 00:19:50,580 --> 00:19:56,820 CoinPayments. We also know that the CoinPayments account was funded with user contributions. 168 00:19:58,620 --> 00:20:03,660 The way CoinPayments worked, all the Bitcoin was commingled, was mixed together. 169 00:20:04,440 --> 00:20:08,460 I've explained this in prior filings and I don't want to get too technical here. 170 00:20:09,480 --> 00:20:17,940 In brief, once Bitcoin hit the CoinPayments system it became one part of one large EminiFX account, 171 00:20:17,940 --> 00:20:22,860 like pouring a glass of water into a big lake. 172 00:20:23,820 --> 00:20:30,000 So when a user withdrew, it was like taking

173 00:20:30,000 --> 00:20:37,380 big lake. However, the lake in this analogy was made up of contributions only. So there 174 00:20:37,380 --> 00:20:43,380 were no profits in the lake in no profits in the CoinPayments account to be more precise. 175 00:20:44,520 --> 00:20:51,060 So when users withdrew over 33 million dollars as they did, that 33 million 176 00:20:51,060 --> 00:20:56,640 dollars came from the CoinPayments account, and it came not from any trading profits, 177 00:20:56,640 --> 00:21:03,840 but from the 182 million dollars that other users had contributed via CoinPayments. 178 00:21:03,840 --> 00:21:10,740 And we can see this very clearly in the CoinPayments records we've obtained. And so that's 179 00:21:10,740 --> 00:21:18,540 why I say that when someone withdrew profits from EminiFX, what they received was other people's 180 00:21:18,540 --> 00:21:26,220 money. Because at no point did withdrawals include any actual trading or investment profits. 181 00:21:31,680 --> 00:21:38,220 You know I've spent a lot of time talking about how EminiFX worked before I was appointed. 182

a small little glass of water from that very

00:21:39,060 --> 00:21:46,800 I want to now turn to the current financial status

of the Receivership. The funds I am holding, 183 00:21:46,800 --> 00:21:53,700 by and large, come from the contributions of users, so I think it's important that we that I 184 00:21:53,700 --> 00:22:01,500 explain what funds I have, where they came from and how my team and I are managing those funds. 185 00:22:02,520 --> 00:22:10,560 First bank accounts. At the beginning of the Receivership, the CFTC and I froze a number of 186 00:22:10,560 --> 00:22:16,980 company and Alexandre bank accounts, including the ones at TD Bank and Bank of America, which many 187 00:22:16,980 --> 00:22:23,580 of you use to contribute funds. Those funds were turned over to the Receivership bank accounts in 188 00:22:23,580 --> 00:22:29,820 the first few weeks of the Receivership. That works out to about 60 plus million dollars. 189 00:22:30,900 --> 00:22:38,400 Second, cryptocurrency. Most of the cryptocurrency that EminiFX had was in the CoinPayments account 190 00:22:38,400 --> 00:22:45,060 that we discussed earlier. So CoinPayments is an offshore company located in Estonia and 191 00:22:45,060 --> 00:22:51,600 then Lithuania, which is in the Baltic region of Europe. So I hired the Baltic Law Firm Sorainen 192 00:22:51,600 --> 00:22:57,600 to assist us, and we were able to recover

all the cryptocurrency held in that account, 193 00:22:57,600 --> 00:23:05,220 over 36 hundred Bitcoin. We also recovered some cryptocurrency in other accounts. 194 00:23:06,420 --> 00:23:13,620 When we started selling the Bitcoin in January 2023, the price was under 17 195 00:23:13,620 --> 00:23:20,580 thousand dollars. That equated to a value of around 62 million dollars for the entire position. 196 00:23:21,960 --> 00:23:27,900 I decided to sell slowly, over the course of four months, to reduce the volatility. 197 00:23:28,800 --> 00:23:34,380 By the time we finished selling, the price of Bitcoin was over 30 thousand dollars. 198 00:23:35,220 --> 00:23:42,960 The average price over those four months for the whole position was a bit more than 24 thousand 199 00:23:42,960 --> 00:23:50,100 dollars, and that means that the cash proceeds from the sale of that cryptocurrency was just over 200 00:23:50,100 --> 00:23:56,520 90 million dollars. And that's a substantial increase from when we first started selling 201 00:23:58,800 --> 00:24:05,700 Third, the brokerage account. I also mentioned that 9 million dollars of EminiFX corporate 202 00:24:05,700 --> 00:24:11,520 money was put into the brokerage account, and

then uh and over seven million dollars was lost 203 00:24:11,520 --> 00:24:18,000 in trading. That works out to about 1.7 million dollars left in the account. When I was appointed, 204 00:24:18,780 --> 00:24:22,560 I liquidated the remaining positions before they could lose more money, 205 00:24:22,560 --> 00:24:28,080 and we recovered that as cash as well fairly early on in the receivership. 206 00:24:30,360 --> 00:24:36,660 Fourth, litigation recoveries. I mentioned earlier the 46 foreclosure properties and the three other 207 00:24:36,660 --> 00:24:43,980 properties for which EminiFX or Affiliates were in contract, but had not yet been purchased. 208 00:24:44,880 --> 00:24:51,060 That meant that we were involved in 46 separate state court cases in Nassau and Suffolk counties. 209 00:24:51,900 --> 00:24:59,100 So I hired the Nassau County firm Forchelli Deegan Terrana, and we were able to achieve 2.5 million 210 00:24:59,100 --> 00:25:03,600 dollars in settlements without having to purchase a single property and with a waiver of claims. 211 00:25:04,560 --> 00:25:09,720 We also recovered and sold a number of vehicles, as well as some office equipment, 212 00:25:09,720 --> 00:25:16,200 although most of that has very little resale

213 00:25:16,200 --> 00:25:24,960 on June 30th 2023. the receivership had a total of 153.7 million dollars under its control, 214 00:25:24,960 --> 00:25:33,260 all in interest bearing accounts. Right now that interest is about 400 thousand dollars each month. 215 00:25:33,260 --> 00:25:40,200 We have had costs as well. At the beginning of the Receivership, we paid the final salaries of the 216 00:25:40,200 --> 00:25:46,680 employees, except for Mr. and Mrs. Alexandre, as well as one month of additional rent. 217 00:25:47,640 --> 00:25:52,920 I explained a lot of those reasons in detail in my June 1 preliminary status report. That website is called investor.gov, and it has a page on Ponzi schemes. 255 00:30:01,620 --> 00:30:04,740 We'll put a link to this page in the notes for this video. 256 00:30:05,820 --> 00:30:12,180 Here are some of the red flags that the SEC on that page has 257 00:30:12,180 --> 00:30:15,540 identified as warning signs for Ponzi Schemes. 258 00:30:16,380 --> 00:30:23,700 First, High returns with little or no risk. The SEC notes that "Every investment carries 259 00:30:23,700 --> 00:30:29,160 some degree of risk, and investments yielding higher returns typically involve more risk." 260 00:30:30,060 --> 00:30:36,300 The SEC warns, "Be highly suspicious of any 'guaranteed' investment opportunity." 261 00:30:38,220 --> 00:30:45,360 Second, overly consistent returns. As the SEC notes, "Investments tend to go 262 00:30:45,360 --> 00:30:51,900 up and down over time." So the SEC also warns, "Be skeptical about an investment

263 00:30:51,900 --> 00:30:57,060 that regularly generates positive returns regardless of overall market conditions."

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00:31:00,540 --> 00:31:07,860 Third, secretive, complex strategies. The SEC cautions investors to "Avoid

Things like bank statements, 319 00:37:31,800 --> 00:37:37,320 wire confirmations, but even emails, text messages depending on the circumstances could be useful. 320 00:37:37,980 --> 00:37:45,360 So I encourage users to provide what information they can given the circumstance that they have. 321 00:37:45,360 --> 00:37:50,760 Depending on where the disagreement is, we'll also be able to reach out if we need more information, 322 00:37:50,760 --> 00:37:59,040 but again, I would say give us as much as you can ideally in PDF format. When you 323

And their the ROI the 5 to 9 percent was 328 00:38:37,080 --> 00:38:43,560 never real is not something that we will continue. We would ever continue because again it's not 329 00:38:43,560 --> 00:38:51,120 based on reality. To give you maybe a different way of explaining that, so the minimum ROI was 5%, 330 00:38:52,020 --> 00:38:58,380 so if we take that forward to now, the dashboard balance the collective dashboard balance, 331 00:38:58,380 --> 00:39:04,500 and assuming no more withdrawals, no deposits, we just took what was in EminiFX when I took over, 332 00:39:04,500 --> 00:39:12,240 and took 5% to now, the dashboard balance would be around 14 billion dollars. To make

00:39:12,240 --> 00:39:20,640 that work Bitcoin would have to be between 3.5 and 4 million dollars per coin. Right now, it's around 334 00:39:21,660 --> 00:39:30,600 25,000. So there was just there's no ROI continuing. We're not going to pay based on 335 00:39:30,600 --> 00:39:36,840 anything that's not real, and that just wasn't real. Now there is interest, as I mentioned, 336 00:39:36,840 --> 00:39:42,420 on the Receivership accounts, so that interest gets paid directly into the Receivership. So we've received a number of questions, 352 00:41:34,380 --> 00:41:40,140 maybe comments, tips I would almost call them from users over the past year or so,

Say it again cftc.gov/complaint. 359 00:42:28,320 --> 00:42:35,880 The SEC, the Securities Exchange Commission, also has a tip line and it's the sec.gov/TCR. 360 00:42:41,280 --> 00:42:45,480 You can also report any potential crimes of course to the FBI or to local police, 361 00:42:45,480 --> 00:42:55,080 as appropriate. But in general we are here just to focus on the EminiFX case and to for me to 362 00:42:55,080 --> 00:43:01,680 administer the assets there and not other schemes. I think we've received a couple more questions
